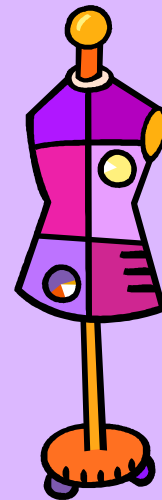

**Sewing with your child.** Ages 5-9 Introduction to basic sewing while allowing for varied skill levels. Children will be introduced to basic fabrics, constructions techniques, create their own patterns or just create. The focus will be on the children but the adults will find time to hone their own skills. Material lists will be supplied for projects and necessary supplies. Machines will be available for use. Class sizes will be limited. **Wednesday 3:30-5:00.** Six weeks @ \$85.00/couple

**Introducing your child to sewing.** Ages 8-12 (Range may be adjusted if appropriate with instructors' permission). This class will be free flowing- student driven to allow for creative participation. Wow your friends with your creations! If you can dream it we can make it! Adult participation will be required on a rotating basis. Machines will be available for use. Classes will be held on **Thursdays 3:30-5:00 pm.** Material lists will be supplied for projects and necessary supplies. Class sizes will be limited. Six weeks for @ \$85.00

**Creative Fashions with Teens in mind:** Learn clothing manufacturing with a focus on personalization of your garments. Includes students of all skill levels. Design your own from basic patterns or spice up your life with garment changing techniques. Remake that favorite old classic into a modern, fashion WOW. Class will allow students to create what interests them with the guidance of an experienced instructor. Supply list will be given to students. Machines will be available for use or bring your own. Class sizes will be limited. **Monday 3:30-5:00** Six weeks @ \$85.00

**Not your Mother's Sewing Class:** Ages 18 and over. Each member of the class learns at their own level focusing on their interests and skills. Techniques include all basic skills and moves you right into the creative side of sewing. Curtains to clothing, recycle the old into new, save money, enhance your life and home with your original vision. Class will allow students to create what interests them with the aid and guidance of an experienced instructor. Supply list will be given to students. Machines will be available for use or bring your own. Class sizes will be limited. **Thursdays, 5:45-7:15.** Six weeks \$85.00

**Workshop.** Includes access to equipment and instructor to facilitate personal projects or expand your current skills. Access will be for 2 hours per week on **Wednesday evenings 5:00 to 7:00 pm.** Participants supply their own materials and basic needs. Recommended list will be provided.
